

HAZOP Leader Training

COURSE DESCRIPTION

R4Risk's HAZOP Leader Training is a three-day program designed to equip participants with the knowledge and practical skills needed to lead Hazard and Operability (HAZOP) studies effectively. Through a combination of theoretical content and hands-on exercise, the course develops a strong foundation in HAZOP methodology, facilitation techniques and leadership responsibilities.



WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

The HAZOP Leader training is designed for experienced HAZOP team members who are in, or moving into, HAZOP leadership roles.

COURSE CONTENT

The HAZOP Leader training is split into two parts:

- Part 1: HAZOP theory
- Part 2: Practicing HAZOPs.

The training course will cover essential HAZOP topics including:

- Fundamentals of the HAZOP methodology, objectives and terminology
- Roles and responsibilities of the HAZOP leader and their team
- Pre-study planning and preparation
- Effective facilitation techniques and HAZOP leadership attributes
- Managing HAZOP workshops and resolving team issues
- Conducting and documenting HAZOP studies
- Post-HAZOP activities, reporting and action follow-up
- Real-world case studies and practical exercises to reinforce learning.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

At the completion of the HAZOP Leader training, trainees will have been provided with the knowledge to assist them to successfully manage HAZOP studies, including:

- Understanding the purpose and methodology of HAZOP studies
- A thorough approach to workshop preparation
- Application of effective facilitation techniques
- Effective management of the HAZOP study team
- Recording of HAZOP workshop minutes
- Delivery of concise HAZOP reports.

Trainees will possess the knowledge and skills to allow them to become competent HAZOP Leaders based on practice, coaching and their engineering experience.
