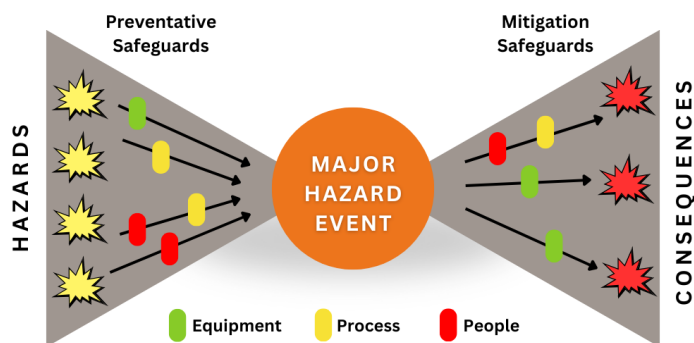


Introduction to Bowtie Analysis Training

COURSE DESCRIPTION

R4Risk's Introduction to Bowtie Analysis is an interactive, online training course designed to provide a practical foundation in Bowtie risk analysis. Participants will explore key concepts and methodology and gain hands-on experience through a staged case study. The course is delivered over two half-day sessions and is ideal for those involved in risk management, safety assessments or incident prevention.



WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

The Introduction to Bowtie training is designed for those who are new to the Bowtie technique. This may include managers, operators, HSE advisors and engineers.

COURSE CONTENT

This two-part training course introduces participants to the principles and practical application of Bowtie Analysis. The course covers:

- The fundamentals and purpose of Bowtie Analysis
- Key concepts: hazards, causes, controls, consequences and impacts
- Step-by-step Bowtie methodology, including risk assessment and risk reduction options
- When and how to use Bowtie Analysis in risk management
- Case studies and exercises to reinforce learning
- Post-analysis activities, including performance standards, action tracking and communication strategies.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

At the completion of the Introduction to Bowtie Analysis Training, participants will be able to:

- Understand the principles and structure of Bowtie Analysis
- Apply the methodology to identify hazards, causes, controls and consequences
- Develop a Bowtie diagram for use in risk assessments
- Evaluate the effectiveness of risk controls and identify improvement opportunities
- Use Bowtie diagrams as a communication and risk management tool.
